Note EOI criteria (In more detail at EOI Information: For the 2021 Mulberry Festival, the committee will:

- a. Prioritise and only accept food stalls that have healthy real vegetarian food (Note: We will not accept any stalls that sell sugary fizzy soft drinks, or any junk foods)
- b. Seek to prioritise the number of our unique local and regional artisan and craft stalls (no pre purchased, on sell items)
- c. Seek to be plastic bag / plastic cutlery / plastic serving container / plastic drink bottle free (you should plan to use alternatives) In our media / advertising we will be asking visitors to the Festival to bring own bags. We will also have a water refill station and a mug library
- d. Ask that you reflect basic Sustainability ethos in your stall

Generators / Power: For Stalls needing power and supplying own, there will be STRICT requirements around noise and fumes. All electrical cords MUST be tagged by an approved person. They will be checked on the day. There will be limited power outlets available so your own quiet / clean power supply is preferred.
